Locksmith Licensing Update

The Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Board met on March 5th, 2007 at 0905 am. The following items were discussed :

Members present were: James Perry, Mike Nelson, Bob Carrol, Matt Schue, Steve York, and Rick Brown.

Members Absent: Paul Juneau, Drake McDannold, and LaRue Medders.

The Following Companies applying for Licensure consideration and approved:

a) Beasley Technology, Inc. (Oklahoma), (Closed Circuit TV).

Manager: Geoffrey W. Beasley

b) Flash Fire protection, Inc. (Oklahoma), (Commercial Fire Sprinkler).

Manager: Joey D. Males

c) Doug Mounce. (Oklahoma), (Closed Circuit TV, Access Control, Nurse Call).

d) AFC Locksmith, Inc. (Oklahoma), (Locksmith)

The Following Items were Discussed:

b) All Proposed changes to 310.205 have been submitted to the O.S.D.H. commissioners for approval and if approved by them submitted to the OK State Legislators for their approval

c) OKBFAA has requested the State Fire Marshal Office be contacted to see if anything can be done to decrease the amount of time it takes to have plans approved by the State Fire Marshal's Office.

d) OMLA was requested to speak on HB2773, This bill in its original form would have required all Prime and General Contractors, Subcontractors, Independent Contractors, and Persons engaged in contract labor, who through negotiations or Competitive bidding, enter into contracts to furnish labor, materials, or both and who have the required equipment to perform the contract. At this time that version of the bill has completely changed and is no longer a threat to any of the locksmiths, Access control, CCTV, and Nurse call companies in OK.

e) SB45 CCR2 was discussed. The Board was informed the house had passed the bill and sent it to the Governor and he had signed it on March 4 2008. This bill will take affect on 1 Nov. 2008. It will allow all Lumber yards to do anything a Licensed Locksmith does at this time but with out going through any of the License back ground check, license process or paying any of the Fees.

f) Matt Schue was appointed as the Director of the Occupational Licensing Division. Mr. Schue will continue to sit on the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Committee as the Commissioner's Designee.

The Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Committee adjourned at 10:35 am.

**Locksmith Licensing Update
By Charles D Hudecek**

The Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Board met on April 6th 2008 at 09:02 A.M.
The following items were discussed:

- 1) Advisory Board
 - a) Members Present were: James Perry, LaRue Medders, Paul Junrau, Matt Schue, and Rick Brown
 - b) Members Late: Drake McDannold
 - c) Members Absent: Steve York, Mike Nelson, and Bob Carrol
- 2) The Following Companies applied for Licensure consideration and were approved:
 - a) Dave's Safe & lock, LLC. (Oklahoma),(Locksmith) Manager: David Baker
 - b) Digital Dynamics, LLC (Oklahoma),(CCTV) Manager: Bradlee Hadsall
 - c) Wunderlich-Malec Services, Inc. (Minnesota),(CCTV) Manager: Roy Marin, Jr.
 - d) Thresholds, LLC (Oklahoma),(CCTV) Manager: Paul C. Richardsthis
 - e) Independent Alarm Company (Oklahoma),(Burglar Alarm, Commercial Fire Alarm, Moitoring, CCTV, Access Control and, Nurse Call) Manager: Robert Traughber
- 3) The Following items were discussed:
 - a) The review and discussion of 59-1800.13, Para B, Sub-Section 2 was conducted by the Legal Department. of the Department of Health (the applicant licensee has committed any offense resulting in the applicant's conviction of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude. Provided, however, if the applicant has had no felony conviction within the last ten (10) years prior to making application for a license and said applicant has shown the committee that the applicant has been rehabilitated, the committee may recommend said applicant be issued a license.)

This Discussion was in 2 parts:
Part 1: This applies equally to all applications for Licensure after the grandfather period ended. (Jan 1, 2007 – April. 2, 2007)
If anyone is convicted of a felony within 10 years prior to applying for a license, his application will be denied by the Department of Health and not go forward to the Advisory Board. If the felony conviction occurred more than 10 years prior to application, it will be reviewed by the Advisory Board and may or may not be approved for Licensure.

Part 2: This only applies to applicants who have never held a license from the O.S.D.H. and made application during the grandfather period. (Jan 1, 2007 – Apr. 2, 2007). This only applies to the Locksmith, CCTV, Access Control, and Nurse Call categories. It does not apply to the Alarm, Fire, and Burglary categories.
 - b) The Advisory Board will begin reviewing all applications with Felony issues as outlined above, at the next monthly meeting (May 7th, 2008)
 - c) A marking tag to indicate a unit is the process of repair but can't be completed immediately (waiting parts, etc.) (so the inspection personnel know a problem is being addressed) was discussed and will be added to the appendix in July 2008.
 - d) CIB Board is moving forward with the rules for SB45.
 - e) A request was made to the Advisory Board to acquire from the Tax Commission, a SIC code and a "by name" list specifically stating exactly who SB45 CCR2 applies to.
 - f) O.S.D.H. will start sending follow-up letters to every applicant for which additional information has been requested and not yet received.

If you have not received your license, you either have a felony or you haven't sent the additional information as requested. Time to get this information in is growing short.

If additional info has been requested and you don't send it in so your license can be issued, at renewal time July 1st, 2008, there will be no renewal and you could be risking forfeiture of your license and permission by the State to conduct business pending initial license issue.
