The Alarm & Locksmith Industry Act (SB1741) passed the Senate on (3/9/6) with a vote of 39 yea & 4 nay. If approved and no changes are made, the Joint committee will get it and approve. It would go to the Governor for signature and become law.

### **The Alarm & Locksmith Industry Act (SB1741)**

**The bill passed the Senate at 9:42AM today (3/9/6) with a vote of 39 yea & 4 nay. (We don't know the HB # yet) It will now go to the House committee for their review, then on to the full House for their vote. If approved and no changes are made, the Joint committee will get it and approve. It would go to the Governor for signature and become law.**

**Lowell was there that day for any questions. There were none. The bill passed without discussion. He and Charles continue to meet with committees and individual Representatives weekly to insure no questions go unanswered and to help any way possible. Work still continues, and we are now waiting on the Oklahoma Legislature to complete the Law and put it into effect. Possibly by the end of 2006. 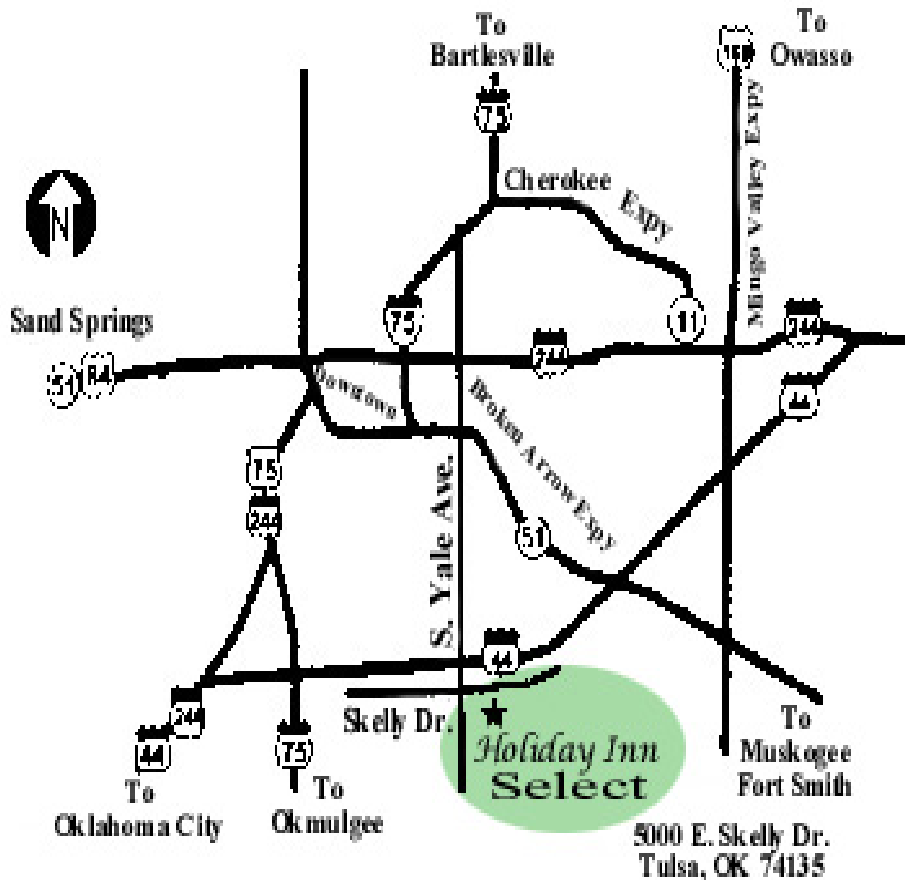

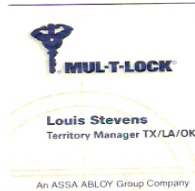
