### Locksmith Licensing Update By Charles Hudecek

**The Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Board met on October 3rd, 2007 at 0920 am.  
The following items were discussed :**

The advisory board requested that OMLA members be contacted and solicit their opinions prior to the next board meeting and have those opinions expressed, so I will be contacting locksmiths at random via phone to solicit views about this and other areas of concern during the phone conversations, so be prepared to share your views when called.

1) The possibility of establishing sub-classes of locksmith licensing.

This discussion centered around possible establishment of a sub-category in the locksmith licensing for car openers, (not auto locksmith) and how it might effect the overall licensing in the locksmith categories.

2) Mr. Vernon Bolz ( Dir. Of Occupational Licensing) Stated during the board meeting that O.S.D.H. Occupational Licensing is currently pursuing any and all Phony / Gypsy locksmiths and Companies in the state of OK. And to that end will be hiring a Locksmith Investigator.

3) The board voted to remove Alarm and Locksmith Industry rule 310 - 205 - 3 - 2 ( f ) Pre -licensing and course approval requirements. There are now no approved providers. Any interested party would take the test, If they pass they get a license

4) According to Mr. Matt Schue, the O.S.D.H. web site has all licensed Companies and individuals listed on their web site as of September 15th, 2007.

5) The next Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Board meeting will be on November 7, 2007 at 9:00 AM at Oklahoma State Department of Health, 1000 NE 10th Street, room 806, Oklahoma City, OK.

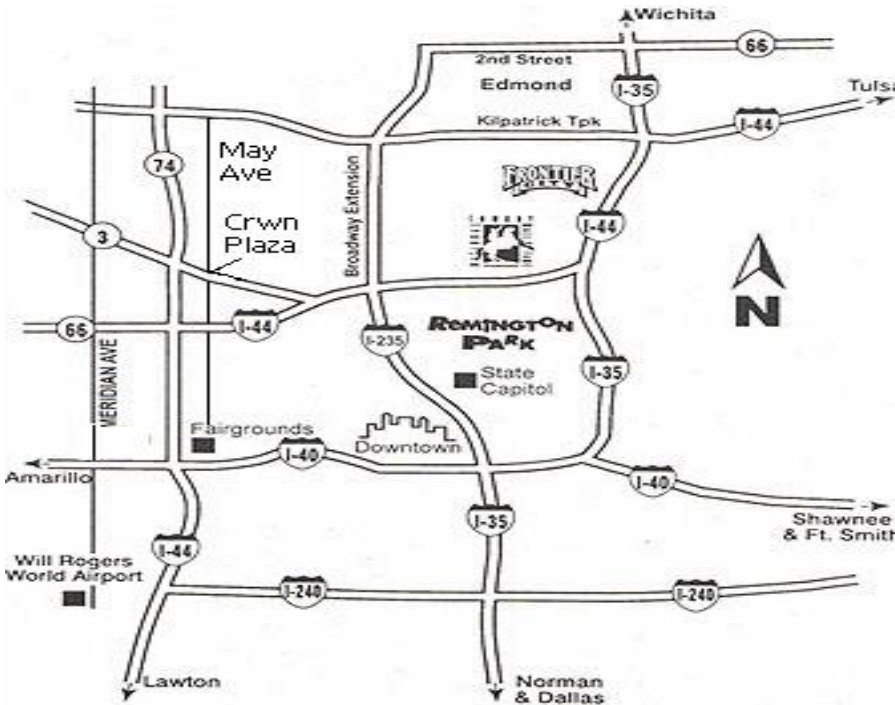
